FESTIVAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- All Material Must have Country Content unless performed in Sections 10 & 12.
- Contestants are responsible for their own musical backing. However, arrangements can be made by approaching the Stage Manager. There will be backing musicians available for the weekend if needed. Three basic chord charts must be provided. Pre-recorded backing is **not** permitted except for in Sections **10 & 12.**
- Sound equipment, Drum kit and P.A; will be supplied by Redcliffe Country Music Club. All equipment will be under the control of the Sound Engineer.
- Entry is open to amateur, Semi-professional and non-club members.
- Contestants may enter only once per section, with the exception of Song Writing.
- Contestants to follow M.C. or Stage Manager's instruction.
- All contestants must check in with Stage Manager or Assistants 30 minutes before their section commences. Failure to comply may result in disqualification.
- Stage dress. Neat attire to be worn on stage. No thongs permitted.
- The Judges decision will be final and **no** correspondence will be entered into. **Judging** sheets will be available for collection by a club Official, only after the presentation of trophies etc.
- Entry fees are not refundable.
- All contestants must sign the Agreement stating they will abide by the rules.
- In Group/Duet section, please state name of Group/Duet.
- If known, could you please include which backing band you will be using for convenience of program.
- Contestants competing in section 3 can also compete in section 8.
- If using backing discs in sections 10 or 12 please indicate on entry form.
- In sections 10 & 12 backing vocals are permitted. Persons providing backing vocals are seen as part of the backing band for this act so backing vocalist may also enter these sections.
- Final Concert: The Final Concert will be held at the end of competition. Saturday Finalists (except Open Country Rock) will be announced during Section 11 Open Country Rock. Remaining Finalists will be announced on Sunday. Winners from Anything Else, Gone But Not Forgotten and Songwriting will not be included in finals concert. Finalists will be required to perform 2* songs (show your versatility), material choice is your own however all songs performed must be Country. No vocal harmonies permitted in Vocal solos and instrumental backing is your choice.
- Whilst every effort will be made to adhere to the Program, Festival organizers accept no responsibility for inconvenience caused by program alterations arising from unforeseen circumstances.

Redcliffe Country Music Club will take reasonable care; however, we will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to persons or property during the Festival.

PARENTS: Children **must** be supervised during the Festival and are not permitted access to Trotting Track, out buildings or grounds except for the immediate vicinity of Dalton Hall. The dressing room area has kindly been supplied for our use by the Peninsula Darts Association. Please respect the area and how it is kept.

VANDALISM: This is a problem and we do not wish to have complaints from the Show Society. Redcliffe Country Music Club is not responsible for any damages. NO DRINK Eskys allowed in Hall due to Licensing laws. In keeping with Government regulations re-Public Halls, there will be **no smoking** permitted in the halls or within 4 metres of a public entrances or where food is being served. There will be a smoker's area available for the event.
